- Complete manhole inspections that are either incomplete or absent.
- · Provide records of cleaning quantity.
- Provide justification for cutting obstructions.

# Progress since last Infratrack meeting on 1-9-15

None.

### **Proposed Schedule**

No answer yet.

### **Budget Evaluation.**

- Upon completion of the above work and acceptable submittal of the documentation and videos, Infratrack should be due \$23,840 for bid items. This would take the Contract price to \$170,907 which is very close to the bid price.
- Currently, the change order amount would be an additional \$25,485.98 for the extra cleaning.
- This leaves \$11,075.00 that should be paid for various extra work items authorized by the City.
- Any cost more than \$25,711.80 cannot be legally included in a change order for items not bid.
- The engineering budget is currently at \$19,900 which is over budget by \$12,400.
- Overall, the budget for the available funding for this project is over by \$8,479. This does not
  include the \$6,954 recently paid by the City for extra work items.

# **Liquidated Damages**

- \$500 per day.
- Project completion date was October 1, 2014.
- This amounts to 173 days late. We can attempt to assess liquidated damages for the whole time, but most likely this will be battled with some type of litigation and possibly would not be enforced. An alternative is to justify the costs of actual damages.
- Extra work established and agreed upon on January 9, 2015.
- In my opinion, the, weather was conducive for completing the work starting on March 9, 2015. This is 14 days of no action with no excuse. Amounts to \$7,000.
- We could also try to justify additional liquidated damages by the engineering cost overrun.

# Dear Mr. Zahn:

The following is a list of manhole locations that should be cleaned and/or televised before the Contract with the City of Miller is considered complete. These are the items that were discussed at the meeting on January 9, 2015.

1. 4 west (car wash)	13.78 to 77, cut lateral
2. 23 north (previous sewer gas	14.78 south
issue)	15.85 west and/or 84 or 76 east
<ol><li>Cut roots and inspect 25 north.</li></ol>	16.104 south
4. 27 to 28	17.87 east and/or 88 west
5. 28 to 30	18.88 east
<ol><li>Remove obstructions to inspect</li></ol>	19.115 north
east of 32, 33 and 34	20.131 south
7. Cut pipe to access 44 to 43	21.111 north and east
8. 54 west	22.146 west, cut lateral
9. 64 to 65	23.148 west
10.67 to 68	24.156 east
11.71 to 148	25.162 south
12.77 east	26. Storm Sewer 43 north and east

Complete the manhole inspection records that are either incomplete or absent entirely. According to Section 02767, Paragraph 3.02 G of the specifications:

The inspection records shall include a video and photograph of the inside of each manhole and inlet along with records of deficiencies. The Contractor shall include with the manhole records the orientation of each invert, the direction of flow, the type and size of each pipe and the depth (measured to the nearest ¼ inch) from the manhole rim to each invert near the wall of the manhole.

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The quantities submitted by your office on different occasions have indicated discrepancies. Please provide your most recent tabulation of the pipe cleaning quantities.

At this time there does not seem to be good justification for payment of the cutting of existing obstructions. There have been no records provided for such cutting other than displaying a photograph of rocks and pipe pieces that supposedly were removed from the sewer. Provide some sort of documentation or letter that describes justification for the payment of the obstruction removal.

The City of Miller wants oversight on the remaining work that is to be completed by your crews. A representative of the City of Miller will be assigned to observe the work and situations discovered when completing the work. Should you or one of your crews fail to notify the City of Miller or SPN and complete work which does not have the opportunity to be observed by the City's representative, that work will not be accepted.

Upon completion of the remaining work Infratrack shall submit the following items to SPN as soon as possible:

- A tabulation of the footage of all recently completed sewer cleaning by size and type.
- 2. A tabulation of the footage of all recently completed sewer televising by size and type.
- 3. Two digital copies of the recently completed televising records and manhole inspection records.
